

NSW Business COVID-19 Restrictions and Resources

As of 22 December

In Greater Sydney the one person per four square metre rule will be re-introduced for all indoor settings.. Please see the <u>NSW COVID page</u> from a full list of affected suburbs. Please also exercise a high level of caution as you continue to operate.

In the Northern Beaches, automotive businesses can stay open and customers may attend workshops for repairs, however it is recommended businesses exercise a high level of caution and discretion when operating. Enforce contactless transactions, limit public access on premises, and if possible speak to your customers through the phone only. HERE is our no public access sign.

For the remainder of NSW, there are no recent changes in restrictions as yet. There are density quotas in place still of 1 person per 2 square metres, however proceed with caution, practice good hygiene and review your COVIDSafe plan. Having a COVID-19 Safety Plan in place will help minimise risk of transmission of COVID-19 on your premises.

Businesses should also consider the benefits of <u>registering as COVID Safe</u>.

Ensure you have completed the plan in consultation with your workers, then share it with them.

You can either use the provided <u>COVID-19 Safety Plan</u> to address the checklist of matters, or keep using your existing plan, if you have one, after making sure it includes all the items in the provided COVID-19 Safety Plan. You must <u>review the following</u> requirements before completing your COVIDSafe plan:

- Physical Distancing
- Two or Four Square Metre Rule
- Face Masks
- Self-isolation and Quarantine
